REMOVAL

- 1. Gently pry trim bezel from console using a trim stick (Mopar tool number C-4755 or equivalent). Remove the shift lever bezel as shown.
- 2. Remove the shift lever bolts and the shift lever.

ASSEMBLY

3. Using the trim stick separate the shifter boot from the shift lever.

- 4. Turn boot inside out. Slide over ferrule on the Mopar® shifter assembly until the end of the boot is in line with the bottom edge (with the flats) of the ferrule.
- 5. Secure tightly with tie wrap making sure to position it in the groove between the collar and the bottom edge of the ferrule.
- Reinstall shift lever into shifter assembly. Reinstall shift lever mounting bolts into shifter assembly. Tighten the bolts to 20 N•m (15 ft. lbs.). Snap bezel back in place.
